Statement of intent.

Disclosure of information.

We will keep your "personal information" confidential, and will not supply it to any third party without your consent, other than our suppliers except in cases where we believe that the law requires us to do so, or it is necessary to protect "Morecambe Press's" rights and/or property.

If we use third parties to process your information on our behalf (for example, to create logos, artwork, printing plates, to send out mailings, or deliver to you), we require them to keep your information secure and they are forbidden to use it for their own business purposes.

Some of our suppliers or the services they provide may originate from outside Europe, such as the United States, and by providing personal information to us; you consent to your information being processed on our behalf in other locations.

The information that you supply will be held within the European Union and will not be wholly transferred to another location without your prior knowledge.
